

## **UTERINE SARCOMAS – CURRENT THERAPEUTIC OPTIONS**

### **Abstract**

Uterine sarcomas are rare but very aggressive uterine malignancies originating from mesenchymal elements of the uterine wall. They are classified by the “Gynecologic Oncology Group” in non-epithelial neoplasms and mixed epithelial-nonepithelial tumors, each category presenting different features and prognostic factors. In this review we present the main characteristics and the current therapeutic options for each type of primary uterine sarcoma and for their recurrences.
